Churchill and Blakedown flytipping fines:

11th January 2022

February 2019 business waste was found illegally deposited on New Wood Lane, Blakedown, Kidderminster. Upon writing out to the business they were able to identify who they had handed their waste to. There waste was also found elsewhere which was also removed by the same person. Due to there being multiple incidents the decision was made to take the case straight to court. This case was postponed until march 2022 so yet to have an outcome for this case.

Between 8th June and 7th August 2019- Male pleaded guilty to four charges of dumping controlled waste without the necessary permit in Waggon Lane between June 8 and August 7, 2019. At Kidderminster Magistrates' Court on Wednesday, April 7, The male was fined £535 and was ordered to pay compensation worth £1015, plus court costs of £775 and £35 victim surcharge.

07/05/2020 multiple black bags found deposited on Hurcott Lane, Kidderminster. Name and address found and upon writing out to this person they stated they couldn't explain how waste connected to them had been deposited a £200 fixed penalty notice was issued and paid.

28/05/2020 multiple black bags found deposited on Iverley Lane, Kidderminster. Name and address found and upon writing out to this person they stated they couldn't explain how waste connected to them had been deposited a £200 fixed penalty notice was issued and paid.

01/07/2020- Small amount of waste found deposited on New Wood Lane, Kidderminster. Name and address found within the waste. No correspondence from male so fixed penalty notice was issued. No payment was made therefore the case was handed to the legal department.

30/09/2020- multiple black bags found deposited on Waggon Lane, Kidderminster. Name and address found and upon writing out to this person they stated they couldn't explain how waste connected to them had been deposited a £200 fixed penalty notice was issued and paid.

17/11/2020- Old carpets and packaging found on Rocky Lane, Kidderminster. Name and address found amongst the waste and upon writing out to this person they stated that they didn't know how waste of there's was found illegally deposited. The male was issued with a £200 fixed penalty notice which was paid.

27/07/2021- Male was caught by a member of the public disposing of kitchen units on Hurcott Lane, Kidderminster although once the male was approached by the member of the public he took his items back away with him but as the offence was already set and the male has previously been caught for fly tipping we issued the male and he paid a £400 fixed penalty notice.

05/09/2021 at 17:40hrs Male was caught on CCTV footage disposing of multiple bags of garden waste on Waggon Lane, Kidderminster. Male very quickly paid a £400 fixed penalty notice.

Wolverley and Cookley-

18/01/2019- waste found illegally deposited on Drakelowe Lane- Names and addresses found within the waste. Upon writing out to the individual it was identified that she failed her duty of care by not getting a receipt or checking for a waste carriers license. A fixed penalty notice was issued but not paid. The case was handed to our legal department and we are still awaiting a result.

14/02/2019- Waste found on Drakelowe Lane- Name and address found. No explanation was offered from the householder as to why their waste was found illegally deposited. A fixed penalty notice was issued and not paid. On Thursday 13th May 2021 a women who had a warrant out for her arrest for failing to attend court for the offence of failing her duty of care- handing her waste over to a 'random bloke in the street' handed herself in at the police station and was immediately taken to court. Jade Tonks pleaded guilty to the offence and due to her personal circumstances was ordered to pay a fine of £300 and a victim surcharge of £34.

04/05/2020 at 15:34hrs male was caught on CCTV footage disposing of delivery boxes on Common Barn Lane, Kidderminster. Male ignored most of my correspondence but ended up paying a £400 fixed penalty notice.

08/06/2020- Male was caught on CCTV on three separate occasions disposing of garden waste on Axborough lane, Kidderminster. The male was apologetic and explained he didn't want to sit in the queue for the tip. The male paid £900 in fixed penalty notices.

24/06/2020- multiple black bags found deposited on Beechtree Lane, Kidderminster. Name and address found and upon writing out to this person they stated they couldn't explain how waste connected to them had been deposited a £200 fixed penalty notice was issued and paid.

10/08/2020- Waste deposited (cannabis) on Axborough Lane, Kidderminster- Police informed us they knew the landlord of where the waste had come from. Landlord had failed his duty of care as he didn't check for a waste carriers license or waste transfer notes so was issued with a £200 fixed penalty notice.

17/08/2020- multiple black bags and cardboard boxes found deposited on Beechtree Lane, Kidderminster. Name and address found and upon writing out to this person they stated they couldn't explain how waste connected to them had been deposited a £200 fixed penalty notice was issued and paid.

17/11/2020- packaging from carpets deposited on Beechtree Lane, Kidderminster. Name and address found and upon writing out to this person they stated they couldn't explain how waste connected to them had been deposited a £200 fixed penalty notice was issued and paid.

20/11/2020 at 20:55hrs male caught on CCTV footage disposing of wooden pallets on Axborough Lane, Kidderminster. The male was issued with a £300 fixed penalty notice which was paid.

08/12/2020- Large fly tip discovered on Blakeshall Lane, Kidderminster multiple names and addresses found. 1 paid fixed penalty notice for failure of duty of care. Other cases handed to legal department.

20/01/2021 at 08:18hrs male was caught on CCTV footage disposing of a Christmas tree on Axborough Lane, Kidderminster. £300 fixed penalty notice was issued and paid the male wasn't from Wyre forest so travelled a distance to dispose of this.

11/02/2021- Fly tip found in the lay-by on Beechtree lane, Kidderminster 2 names and addresses found amongst the waste

22/02/2021- Multiple fly tips along Common Barn Lane, Kidderminster. Name and address found in the different fly tips matching. Upon writing out to this person they stated that she had paid a man to dispose to waste but didn't take any of the relevant details to be able to identify him. A £200 fixed penalty notice for failing their duty of care. This was not paid and the case was handed to our legal department.

04/03/2021 and 05/03/2021 male was caught on CCTV footage on Axborough Lane, Kidderminster disposing of car tyres. Vehicle was registered to a business within Wyre Forest, and was issued with 2 fixed penalty notices for fly tipping equalling £600 and also a fixed penalty notice for failure to produce his waste carriers licence and documentation equalling £400.

18/05/2021 at 16:45hrs Male was caught on CCTV footage disposing of garden waste and black bags on Axborough Lane, Kidderminster. Male paid a £300 fixed penalty notice.
