Item 9b & 9c – Budget & Precept considerations for 2025-26		
Report	The clerk met with Cllrs Fowler and Long from the Finance working group on the 21 st November 2024 to start thinking about next years budget. After considering each item, line by line, and looking at the forecast for the end of this financial year, the budget came out an operating cost of £62,318 for the year, an increase of just under £10k on this year's budget. With inflationary increases on the subsidy income from the principal authorities, the precept value that will give us a near balanced budget is £52,750; this requires an increase of 9.48% on last year. With the tax base set at 802, this increases a paying Band D property by £5.91 per year to £65.77pa or £1.26 per week.
