BLAKEDOWN & CHURCHILL - Priorities October - December 25 Burglaries / Rural crime / Vehicle Crime

Our ref **00501_I_11092025** – we received a number of calls in relation to a house party that was held in Forge Lane, Blakedown. Believed to have been an Air B&B that was advertised on social media.

Many units attended and engaged with those present and ultimately, dispersed those in attendance to address the anti-social behaviour. This was further supported by the Duty Inspector authorising a Section 34 dispersal notice to assist officers in their duty. A number of those attempting to drive away were subjected to roadside alcohol breath tests.

Burglary – Swan Close - incident number **00130_I_14092025**.

The burglary took place at approximately 0430 am on Sunday 14th September 2025. Offenders have forced entry to a residential property via side door, breaking fencing and door locks in the process. It is suspected that offenders were attempting to locate keys for an Audi parked on the drive.

We have also had reports of the building site on station drive being broken into causing damage and power tools stolen. A white van was captured on cctv but no registration number visible.
